- any other research and innovation infrastructure of a unique nature which is open to external users







The centrepoint of this pillar is our ambitious plan to build an arts and humanities-friendly component for the European Open Science Cloud (**EOSC**), in the context of the SSHOC project.




The Marketplace is a discovery portal which pools and contextualises resources for SSH research communities: **tools, services, training materials, datasets and workflows**. The Marketplace highlights and showcases solutions and research practices for every step of the SSH research data life cycle. It is **sustained** by a joint effort between CESSDA, CLARIN, and DARIAH and an **Editorial Board**.



### **DARIAH Tools and Services Catalogue**

The DARIAH Tools and Services Catalogue is our showplace for DARIAH resources. The catalogue is broken into Core and Community Services and can be filtered by Provider, Activity, and Category.

## **Premise 1**


In a general context where **GLAM** (Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums) and research data become open and FAIR, an increasing number of projects rely on deploying software provided by the **Wikimedia Foundation** and related initiatives, and **public infrastructures** such as those run by Wikimedia emerge as important or even central repositories of cultural knowledge. We are witnessing more and more fruitful collaboration between DH researchers, GLAM institutions, and members of the Wikimedia movement. This Working Group is a bridge between these three backgrounds, and it understands its work as a contribution towards **Open Science** and the **Commons**.




## **Premise 2**

• More specifically, in the context of DARIAH an increasing number of community members is contributing to or using Wikidata for different purposes. In addition, Wikibase has recently emerged as a software solution chosen for a wide range of organizations and projects of different kinds and scale. # DARIAH as an enabler for funding (EU level)

#### On a broader, infrastructural level:

- DARIAH's European network facilitates the process of putting together consortium for project funding






